It is January 21st, three weeks since New Year's Day, and by now, of the roughly 42 percent of us who made New Year's resolutions, about 40 percent have broken them. Which is okay. The Statistic Brain Research Institute reports, "People who explicitly make resolutions are 10 times more likely to attain their goals than people who don't explicitly make resolutions." There is something within us as humans that desires to make a fresh start, to become resolved, and then to change.

Like the Ninevites, the Corinthians and the Israelites, we too, live in a time of uncertainty. We exist in a fallen world where resolutions are easily made and easily broken, where each day there is a new opportunity to "repent and believe in the Gospel."

The Stewardship Committee is in the process of mailing our title of time /stewardship of faith commitment forms. Last year parishioners were invited to make a commitment to spend 2 hours each week in prayer and their own spiritual development.

When you receive the form please take a few moments to review it, fill it out; cut in half and bring half to your worship site and place it into a basket and keep the other half as a reminder of your commitment. There will be additional forms at your worship site for each member of your family.

In order to be a part of that kingdom proclaimed in today's Gospel, Jesus called for repentance and belief. For Jesus, repentance referred to a thorough going change of mentality and a commitment to the vision he was preaching.

"Repent" means to "turn around; to walk in the other direction" it is the word used when ashes are given on Ash Wednesday. We are called to turn to God more, to remind ourselves that we are part of His Kingdom which He began and to which we are journeying to its fullness.

Our Lenten program is called "**JOURNEY**". It consists of 6 weekly sessions during the time of Lent that help give us meaning and direction. Registration forms need to be in by January 29th so enough materials can be ordered.

May we continue to respond to Our Lord's call to follow Him and to continue to build His kingdom. *Fr. Leo*

All too often, out of fear, insecurity or even selfishness, we refuse to leave the safe cocoon of existence we have created for ourselves in order to hear the Lord's call and be challenged by his Gospel. Perhaps we need to reflect on what comforts we can sacrifice to be better stewards of God's compassionate life.

**Reading I: Deuteronomy 18: 15-20**

*God will send a prophet from among your kin.*

**Reading II: 1 Corinthians 7: 32-35**

*The people were astonished at Jesus' teaching.*



In just a few weeks, we will hear the words of the Gospel as our foreheads are signed with ashes: "Repent, and believe the Good News". If Jesus sat down with you today for a cup of coffee, and said "I'm interested. Let's talk about repentance. What does that mean for you? Do you have any questions for me about it? What do you think you might need to turn away from in order to have a fuller, richer, holier life? What could you turn away from that would allow you to bring life and love to more people?"

**Year of the Eucharist**

How can we experience our Catholic faith more deeply? Consider this: Jesus, born in lowly conditions, yet recognized by the Magi as a King, was obedient to God the Father, fulfilling His Mission as Savior. He, a King, humbled Himself by His life, death and resurrection to give us eternal life. Every time we partake of Eucharist at Mass, He humbles Himself again, entering us to strengthen us, individually and as a community of believers (the Church).
