Catholic Daughters Court 1173 is holding its annual baby shower and now is including Bath's office along with Penn Yan. The shower will run until the weekend of February 16th. A container will be in the back of church for parishioners to put any donations. Items needed- Diapers size 3,4,5,6. Both centers have smaller sizes. Pacifiers (boy and girl), wipes(sensitive), toddler potty seats, girl's long sleeved onesies, hooded bath towels, boy's 6-12 month PJs and infant board books. Also baby wash/lotion/oil, diaper rash cream, thermometer, clothing needed 12-18-24/2T sizes girls/boys. Some mom and dad needs- body wash/lotion, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, tooth paste/brush, soap, mouth wash, and comb/brush. Moms also need panty liners and hair accessories. Dads also need razors, shaving cream and after shave. A Catholic Daughter will pick up the items collected and distribute them to the two centers.

Test your Catholic IQ:

What is an important teaching revealed by Christ and taught by the Magisterium, which Catholics are required to believe? Answer: Doctrine or Dogma. The terms are used interchangeably.

Currently there are 36. Some of them include: Augustine, Ephraem the Deacon, Cyril of Alexandria, Hildegard de Bingen, Teresa of Avila and Therese de Lisieux.
