Love Our Enemies

That is what we hear in this weekend's Gospel, but do we find it hard to do? I would argue that it takes seeing with God's eyes to be able to do this.

We learned that despite David's ability to murder Saul and his army, he didn't do it because even though Saul had evil intents, David recognized him as anointed by God, so spared him and his army. When we are walking with the Lord, we are practicing kindness, mercy, grace, compassion, healing, forgiveness and redemption.

Love trumps hate.

There is evil and hate in today's world! Take human trafficking, for example. Quoting from a communication from Catholic Charities of Chemung & Schuyler Counties, human trafficking "is a crime involving the exploitation of someone for the purposes of compelled labor or a commercial sex act through the use of force, fraud, or coercion. Human trafficking affects individuals across the world, including here in the United States, and is commonly regarded as one of the most pressing human rights issues of our time." They go on to invite us to learn more about the issue and steps we can take to protect each other because it "effects all ages, genders, ethnic, and socio-economic backgrounds."
