I like reading mysteries. I like planning, knowing what to expect. That is not to say I don't like surprises, but the ones I enjoy are the happy, uncomplicated ones. I'm a bit less comfortable living out mysteries or complicated surprises. How about you?

Today we celebrate The Trinity, One God, three persons: Father, Son & Holy Spirit. There is the first great mystery. Three distinct persons are operating as one. Sure, each has a role: Father, Lover, Creator; Son, teacher, Savior; Holy Spirit, teacher, Helper. One doesn't exist without the other; they can't. Jesus' words in the Bible cannot be clearer.

"I am in the Father and He is in Me. And He does His work through Me. Just believe it -- that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me. These words are not my own, but comes from the Father who lives in me. (John 14:10b-11) "...and to those who love and obey me, we will come to them and live in them. We will send our Holy Spirit to teach you and remind you of everything I have taught you." (John 14:23a & 24b)

Jesus, doing the will of the Father, humbled Himself by coming to live among us as a human (God with us, the Incarnation, the second great mystery). He taught us how to live the Commandments, "full of loving forgiveness and truth." (John 1:14a) He knew he was going to die for the forgiveness of our sins. (That was his mission.) He rose from the dead, ascended into Heaven and sits at the Father's right hand until He comes again (fulfilling the Scriptures/keeping his promises).

Will we be ready? The first Apostles were. They obeyed Him and the Holy Spirit came to live *in them* (the third great mystery). Through the Spirit's strength, they had to fulfill the Great Commission: *"Go make disciples of all nations. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach them to obey all I have taught you. I (in the person of the Holy Spirit) will never leave nor forsake you."* (Matt. 28:19-20)

When our lives are changed by this message (aka, the kerygma), when we tell others The Good News (evangelization), and walk with them, teaching them about God (catechesis or didache), giving them opportunities to serve (building the Kingdom) so that they can encounter God (kerygma), we are doing as God commanded (discipleship). How can we help each other on our journeys?

THE RELEGATION OF ST. THERESA'S CONTINUES

A formal notification for the relegation (making secular so it can be sold) has begun. The Parish Pastoral & Finance Councils have met & based on the estimated cost to repair the church (over \$100,000); the low attendance (about 40 per Sunday) & the low number of families registered at St. Theresa's (20), we have reached consensus that the worship site of St. Theresa's should be relegated. Repair of the worship site would put a severe financial strain on the parish.

At this time, I would welcome any parishioner's observations & suggestions concerning the closing & relegation of St. Theresa's. During the next few weeks, I would appreciate it if you would share in writing any concrete & practical suggestions that you have. Please have the courtesy of signing or putting your name on any correspondence so I can contact you for possible clarification.
