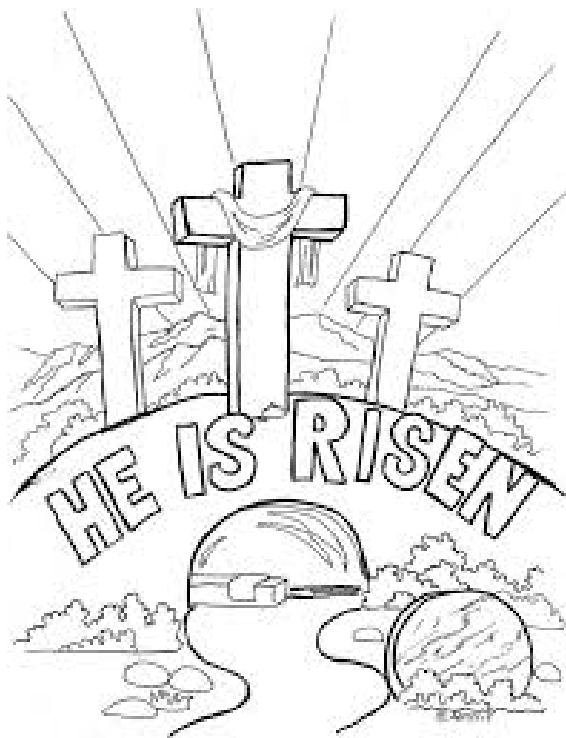


Allelu! Allelu!

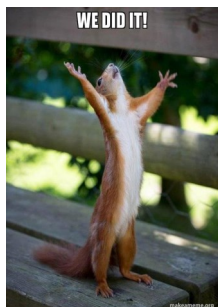

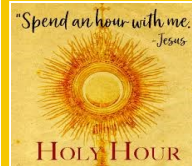
