Are we on the road to righteousness, or counting sins?

Last week we celebrated Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of Jesus' Body & Blood, one of the two feast Sundays that begins this stretch of Ordinary Time.

It was fitting that Bishop Matano chose that weekend for the Sunday obligation of Mass participation to be reinstated. It is by attending and actively participating that we are changed by the Holy Spirit just as the Spirit changes bread and wine into Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul & Divinity. We rely on the hope of God's mercy toward us by proclaiming that "we are not worthy" to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. If we hold others' sins against us, guess what? Those sins block us from a better life today and our eternal destination! That is not what God wants!

Our Mass is the memorial of Jesus' great sacrifice for us, even though "we are not worthy." If we are at peace with our leaders and anyone else in our lives, then we can receive Jesus in the Eucharist. If at the Sign of Peace we are not forgiving of any transgressions against "our neighbors," then to receive anyway profanes Jesus in the sacrament! Jesus, who we should love above all things!

I am reminded of some conversations I have had with parishioners who have been offended by things they witnessed at Mass. Brothers & sisters, if something happens that you find offensive, please take it up with the offender! How can a person's behavior change if they are unaware of their transgressions? It is a Spiritual Work of Mercy to admonish the sinner, no matter who that person may be. It is also a Spiritual Work of Mercy to forgive quickly, as we hope God does with us. Some have said it is those offenses that is keeping them from returning to Mass. Brothers and sisters, if you know someone for whom this scenario applies, please encourage them to open the conversation and come to reconciliation. All of us need the Eucharist, Jesus in us, to navigate the turmoil of this world.

During Ordinary Time we walk with Jesus through the readings. And God walks with us as we offer ourselves as well as our tithes, our sacrifices and gifts of bread and wine (the symbols of life sustaining nourishment). And when we receive Jesus, He works in us, giving us His life to help us be the best people we can be. By being the best we can be, by practicing the mercy and forgiveness we hope to receive from God, by knowing and living our Catholic faith, we can fulfill our mission of bringing others to Christ. Who can God count on?




**Do you want to watch the Mass at Our Lady of the Lakes, but do not want to use Facebook?**

# MASS SCHEDULE CHANGE

## MASS SCHEDULE CHANGES

Thank you all who took time to suggest a Mass schedule for Our Lady of the Lakes beginning in July.

The challenge is to leave enough time between Masses to travel especially considering the weather, buggies & slow drivers which usually takes at least one half an hour under ideal conditions.

Many suggest 3 Masses on Sunday covering the 3 worship sites yet no one suggested the last Mass (usually at 12 or 12:15) to be at their worship site.

I want to supply the opportunity for the parishioners at St. Januarius & St. Patrick's to attend Mass on either Saturday evening or Sunday.

After discussing my recommendations with the staff, the following schedule has been set, to be evaluated in 6 months (January 2022).

### Offering Counter Teams Needed

The offering counters are volunteers who assist in providing **accurate, consistent, confidential** and timely processing of all donations and monetary gifts to the Church.

Offering Counter Teams work in groups of three(3) unrelated people. (i.e. Husband and Wife would be placed on separate teams) Usually the counting work is done immediately after the worship service though it may be set for a later time. Teams serve in a rotating schedule.

These teams count and record the amounts of money and checks and then prepare the deposit slips for delivery to the bank.
